Protect Yourself and Your Loved Ones From COVID-19

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Remember to maintain social distancing precautions of at least 6 feet from your loved one and all other residents.

Visitor Guidance

- Visitors must sign in and will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to the visit.
- You must wear a face mask or face covering over your nose and mouth at all times while on the premises (inside or outside). Residents must also wear a facemask over their nose and mouth when visiting with loved ones. If you do not have a facemask, we will provide you with one.
- Hand sanitizer should be used before and after the visit and as needed.
- New admissions may be on transmission-based precautions or quarantine until tested negative for Covid. Although visitation is not recommended for residents in transmission-based precautions or quarantine, visits may still be allowed in the resident's room with all parties wearing well-fitting masks.
- Although it is safer for visitors not to enter the facility during a Covid 19 outbreak, visitation will be allowed with information given to the visitor about potential risk of exposure.

If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
